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### More information about the venue:

The Immersive School on Plain English takes place at the University of Pavia, in the Department of Humanities, in the former monastery of San Tommaso, which for centuries served as the seat of the powerful Dominican Order in Pavia. Construction of the monumental complex, which also includes an imposing Gothic church, began towards the end of the 14th century. Over the centuries, the complex was remodelled several times until it finally acquired its current function. Thanks to extensive restoration work carried out between 1994 and 2004, the complex is now once again usable as a university site and is regaining its historical cultural significance. Although time and successive changes of use have led to the inevitable loss of much of the artistic heritage, the sacristy and the chapel, commissioned by the noble Bottigella family, are still preserved — a true treasure of the city of Pavia, offering a glimpse of the former splendour of the complex.

During the immersive school, participants will have the opportunity to discover the cloister of the former monastery of San Tommaso and the Bottigella chapel with the adjoining sacristy. All of the school's activities will take place in the Bottigella Chapel, and during breaks participants will be able to visit the Sibyl Hall (*Sala delle Sibille*), which is normally closed to the public. When you enter, you will find yourself surrounded by a fascinating compendium of Renaissance and Mannerist painting.
